We are pleased to share with you a revised version of the [ICC paper on the Post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework](#) which will be resubmitted to the ICC Executive Board.

The original paper, which was initially circulated to you last April, has been [revised](#) to take into account comments by the ICC Executive Board and has been restructured to allow it to be used more flexibly in the lead up to the fifteenth session of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity (COP15). COP15 will take place in Kunming, China in October 2020 where 196 governments are expected to adopt a new post-2020 global framework for biodiversity. ICC intends to mobilise its network to support an ambitious outcome at COP15, including through the [Business for Nature](#) coalition. We look forward to any comments you may have by **16 September 2019**, to allow us to meet the deadline for the next ICC Executive Board meeting. Please make any line changes to the clean version.
