Since the last meeting

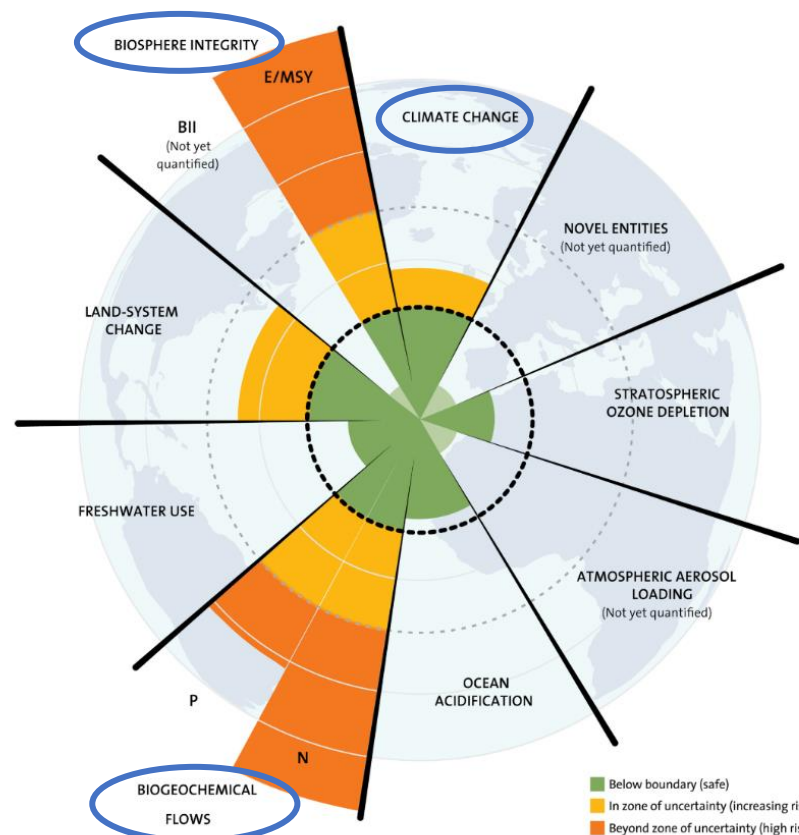

Resource plants replacing wastewater treatment plants in the future

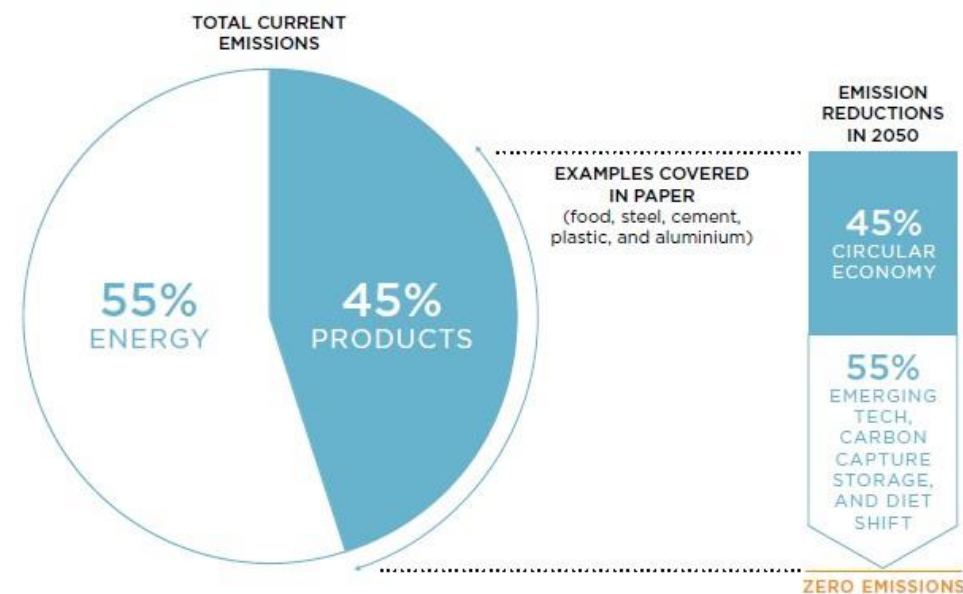
