

Dear all,

I am reaching out to you regarding a call for interest to find trade finance experts to become members of a joint <u>DSI</u> – Banking Commission focusing on validating the data sets as prescribed by DSI's trade documents working group.

This will be an ideal opportunity for candidates to contribute towards the interoperability of the digital trade ecosystem and support a major initiative: digitizing global trade. The new workstream looks to validate the data sets as prescribed by experts from the physical supply chain within the world of financial supply chains. The initial scope will be limited to the 8 data sets set to be finalized early Jan. '23 but the group will also continue and support the validation of all subsequent data sets that follow. Beyond the validation the expectation is for this group to make recommendations for additional or propose amendments to existing data points, all as a means to help drive adoption within the trade finance industry. There will be close collaboration with both ICC DSI Trade Documentation WG and we will also look to engage the ICC BC API WG to support the creation of API standards or guidelines.

Ideal candidates would have an understanding of:

- Financial supply chain products offered by banks and non-bank lenders ranging from traditional trade to forms of supply chain finance
- Trade finance systems (FinTech and Back-office systems)
- Trade Compliance / Regulatory frameworks
- Product Management / Process Engineer / Business Analyst functions
