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Introduction

1. Purpose

- a) To have a better understanding as to how Incoterms® are being used in China
- b) To know the problems involved with the use of Incoterms®
- c) To have factual support for promotion, training and future revision of Incoterms®
- 2. Questionnaire (41 questions + sub-questions altogether. First draft in 09/2022; group of experts meeting on 23/11/2022; sent out in 03/2023)
 - a) Information about the participants (11)
 - b) Information about the use of Incoterms® (22)
 - c) Information about the use of Incoterms®2020 (9)
- 3. Answers: 94 received; 92 valid




About The Participants

- 1. Types of firms: SOEs, private enterprises, joint ventures & WFOEs
- Area of business: manufacturing, trading (including commodities traders)
 & services
- 3. 19 industries: agriculture, forestry, fishery, mining, etc
- 4. Size of business:
 - a) USD100,000 or less for single transaction or yearly trade at USD500,000;
 - b) Single transaction or yearly trade for USD10,000,000 or more
- 5. Regions of trade: every continents




Top Three Trade Terms Used In Export






Top Three Trade Terms Used In Import






Delivery Point Provided in Import & Export Contract








When Doing Container Shipping, Do You Use FOB/CFR/CIF Instead Of FCA/CPT/CIP?





Version Of Incoterms® Is Being Used







When Using Incoterms®2020, Have You Noticed The Changes Made To Incoterms®2010 In Incoterms®2020?

Summary of Findings (1)

- 1. While FOB, CIF & CFR are the most popular, all the 11 trade terms in Incoterms®2020 have appeared within the top three trade terms used
- 2. Top three factors considered when choosing trade terms:
 - a) Freight (44.57%)
 - b) Risk in transport (38.04%)
 - c) Client's preference (35.87%)
- 3. Reasons for choosing the version of Incoterms®
 - a) Incoterms®2020 (59.78%): 1) most recent; 2) clearer; 3) use the new rather than the old
 - b) Incoterms®2010 (30.43%): 1) accustomed to it; 2) more fit for purpose; 3) client's preference
 - c) Incoterms®2000 (9.78%): 1) accustomed to it; 2) clearer; 3) knowing it since college
- 4. Use in domestic trade
 - a) 53.26% know & 46.74% don't know
 - b) 32.61% have used in domestic trade & 67.39% haven't



Summary of Findings (2)

1. No indication of the version of Incoterms® (39.13%)

2. Mismatch

- a) While the top three trade terms used are FOB, CIF & CFR, where delivery happens when the goods on board ship, the top three delivery points provided in sales contract are port/place of destination (58.7%), port of loading (36.96%) & carrier (33.7%)
- b) When container shipping is used, 75% of the users use FOB/CFR/CIF instead of FCA/CPT/CIP
- 3. Dispute arising out of incorrect use of Incoterms®
 - a) 10.87%, arising out of the fees charged at the loading port when using container shipping
 - b) 8.7%, arising out of the wrong choice of trade terms



Reflections What Should and Can ICC Do?

- 1. Promotion and training
- 2. Next revision
 - a) When?
 - b) How? Key issues to be addressed:
 - ① Ongoing incorrect use of FOB/CFR/CIF instead of FCA/CPT/CIP
 - ② Ongoing disputes arising out of the fees charged at the loading port when using container shipping (10.87%)
- 3. Some more?
 - a) Work with other Commissions in the ICC?
 - b) Establish new commissions or sub-commission of shipping and port management?
